

Energy Resources


 Energy cannot be made, but must come from the natural world.

Fossil Fuels


Nonrenewable Resource

Causes Pollution.




Nuclear Energy

- Disrupts the life cycle of aquatic animals, especially Fish.




Solar Energy


- Inexhaustible resource cannot be used up by humans.
